

GENERAL STAY Information

ACCESS & KEYS | We will provide you a four-digit code to unlock the front door, always followed by the # key. We typically do this after you arrive. Please always lock the door behind you, manually from the inside, and by holding down the # key from the outside. Your room is manually keyed; key is in the door lock, and you can return it there upon checkout.

BREAKFAST | Feel free to access the breakfast & snack bar around the clock during your stay. You may use the fridge to store personal items - we recommend labelling them. Fresh brewed coffee is served in an airpot at 7 am, and a homecooked breakfast is served right at 8 am, unless other arrangements are made or you have a whole house rental sans breakfast. Breakfast each morning is "chef's choice," but we do our best to accommodate any dietary restrictions or food aversions you may have.

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT | During peak season months, check-in is 4pm or after; during off-season months, check-in is 2pm or after. Please refer to your confirmation email for check-in time. Check-out is by 11 am, unless other arrangements are made. When you arrive to check-in, just ring the doorbell at the front door.

LAUNDRY | You may access the laundry room; please inquire first to be sure we can have it ready for you.

MERCANTILE | All guests have shopping access in our mercantile. It is not staffed regularly, so please inquire if there's something you'd like to view or purchase.

OUTDOOR SPACES | Seasonally, feel free to use lawn, picnic tables, bbq grill, and firepit outside.

OUTSIDE ALCOHOL | Due to our Oregon Liquor & Cannabis Commission licensing, no outside alcohol of any kind is allowed to be consumed anywhere onsite except for in private guest rooms. We offer beer, hard cider & seltzer, and wine for sale that can be consumed onsite in all spaces - please inquire or see list attached here.

GENERAL STAY Information

PARKING | Please park along the front drive on either side as long as 1). other vehicles can get past you, 2). you do not block the front entry, and 3). you stay on the pavement and do not park on grassy areas.

PETS | For the comfort of all guests and the integrity of our historic building, no pets except ADA-approved service animals are allowed in the inn.

RECREATION ROOM | Please enjoy the recreation room during your stay, including billiards, darts, games, books, and TV.

SMOKING | No smoking or vaping of any kind is allowed indoors. You may smoke in outdoor spaces, minding proximity to others and fire hazards. Please clean up any refuse from smoking.

TEMPERATURE CONTROL | The main floor of the inn is heated in cooler seasons by furnace, and each guest room has a split unit with both heating and cooling options. There is a remote on the wall of your room to control the split unit - we're happy to show you how it works upon check-in.

TV | Each room has a FireTV with Prime Video, a live channel line-up, and access to Netflix and Hulu. Please note any movies that require purchase will be added to your stay balance. Should you need to enter a TV passcode, it is 01234 around the circle on the remote.
